**Changes to the Automobile Statistical Plan
ASP 2014 Data Elements: "T codes"**

General Insurance Statistical Agency (GISA) approved several new data elements in October 2012 to unbundle information related to Private Passenger Vehicle Type of Use Classes. These were introduced as Statistical Plan changes effective with Policy Effective Date January 1, 2014.

For some of the elements, a temporary code of "T" was introduced to be used if the particular data was not captured initially by insurers.

The temporary "T" codes were available for the following fields:

1. Commuting Distance One-way (in kilometers),
2. Annual Driving Distance (in kilometers),
3. Business Use Percentage (%),
4. Rated Operator Marital Status

For Commercial Type of Use Codes two temporary codes, "T1" and "T2", were also introduced to be used if the detailed classification data was not initially available at the time of the introduction of the new coding.

In order to improve the quality and accuracy of data reported and used in statistical exhibits, GISA has made the decision to stop these temporary codes effective with Policy Effective Date July 1, 2017. Please ensure that you will be capturing and reporting information in accordance with this change to the Automobile Statistical Plan.

The Edit Rules and the Statistical Plan will be modified to reflect the above changes.
